HALL HEALTH CENTER



WHAT IS HALL HEALTH CENTER

- > Across from the HUB
- > Primary & specialty care on campus
- > Part of UW Medicine
- > Who will I see for my care?
 - About 40 providers (MDs, NPs, and mental health)
 - About 20 Consulting Nurses (RNs)
- > Serves students & their families
- > Hours of operation

Expect to pay out-of-pocket for medical care in the US

RESOURCES IN YOUR FIRST LANGUAGE

- > Telephone interpreters available at Hall Health at no cost to you; be sure to request in advance (best when making your appointment)
- > Tell your provider if you would like written materials in a language other than English

EXAMPLE OF AN APPOINTMENT

- > Nguyen has a very sore throat
- > Calls Consulting Nurse from home
- > Consulting Nurse tells him to come in at 2PM to see a provider
- Nguyen brings insurance card and Husky Card and checks in at front desk
- > Waits in waiting room to be called back
- > MA calls Nguyen back and takes him to exam room
- > MA takes blood pressure, temperature
- > Nguyen waits for provider to come in
- > Provider comes in, does exam and test for strep throat
- > Provider talks about self-care
- Nguyen goes home



NO-COST SERVICES AT UW

- > Mental health
 - UW Counseling Center
 - Short term mental health support at Hall Health
 - Let's Talk
 - Academic coaching
- > Physical health
 - Consulting Nurse
 - One visit (face-to-face time with an MD or NP) per quarter for problems



Network

> <u>In-network</u>

Doctors and other health care providers approved by your health plan

> Non-network

Doctors and other health care providers not approved by your health plan. You will pay more for these!

EXAMPLE OF BILLING PROCESS

- > Nguyen's provider completes a form after his visit
- > Billing department sends bill to insurance company
- > Insurance company sends Explanation of Benefits to Nguyen
- > Hall Health sends bill to Nguyen

TYPES OF CARE

> Primary

- Check-ups for cough, cold, flu
- Most health needs

> Specialty

Providers that have special advanced training (i.e., endocrinologist, cardiologist, surgeon)

> Urgent

For severe but not life-threatening illness & injury

> **Emergency**

- For life-threatening illness & injury
- > Complimentary & alternative
 - Acupuncture, massage, Chinese medicine



INTERNATIONAL STUDENT HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN







International Student Health Insurance Plan (ISHIP)

The UW international student health insurance plan (ISHIP) is mandatory for all international students with F-1 and J-1 visa status. Students can choose whether to enroll their spouse and children. For more information on the plan and eligibility, see the International Student Health Insurance Plan web page.

- Eligible international students will be enrolled automatically in quarterly/student-only coverage for each quarter they register for classes.
- You can change your coverage plan at any time up to the third Friday of the quarter (October 14, 2016 the tuition due date).
- You may select the annual plan (extends coverage to August 31, 2017) or add a spouse or children up to the October 14, 2016 tuition due date deadline.
- Once you select the annual plan, no changes or cancellations can be made after October 14, 2016 unless you marry or have a child.
- If you marry or have a child after the deadline then you may add them to your plan within 30 days of the event.

Summer Quarter - If you will NOT be registered for courses during summer quarter, you may purchase coverage by selecting annual coverage when you register for courses during autumn, winter or spring quarters.

• Graduate Appointee Insurance Program: If you have a qualifying TA/RA/SA or fellow/trainee appointment for autumn quarter 2016, you may be eligible for the Graduate Appointee Insurance Program (GAIP). If you are eligible for GAIP your ISHIP coverage will be cancelled automatically. Please note that you will need to re-enroll your spouse and children in GAIP.

International Student Health Insurance Plan:

Your insurance is not active unless you register for class(es) and remain registered through the 3rd Friday of autumn quarter (October 14, 2016).

Cost: \$310.00 -- Autumn guarter 2016 insurance

- Annual insurance through summer guarter 2017
- Include dependents in insurance plan

If you chose coverage that includes dependents when you purchased student insurance on MyUW, enroll them now. This will ensure the doctors and other healthcare providers can see they have coverage and allows timely processing of your bills.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COVER?

- > Hall Health Center
 - 75% coverage (\$100 quarterly deductible is waived for most services)
 - 100% coverage for preventative services
- > In-Network
 - 75% coverage (after you pay \$100 quarterly deductible)
 - 100% coverage for preventative services
- > Non-Network
 - 60% coverage (after you pay \$100 quarterly deductible)
 - Preventative services not covered



MEDICAL BENEFITS

- > Preventative services
- > Emergency care
 - Evacuation
- > Inpatient care
- > Rehabilitation
 - Physical therapy, massage therapy, acupuncture
- > Mental health
 - Individual/group therapy and medication management
- > Dental
- > Vision



PHARMACEUTICALS


- > Rubinstein Pharmacy/Network Providers
 - \$20 copay for generic drugs
 - \$30 copay for brand name drugs
 - \$45 copay for non-formulary drugs
- > Non-network providers
 - 50% coverage
 - Up to \$150 maximum per prescription

Your First Visit

- Johnny goes to Hall Health Center and sees a Consulting Nurse (at no charge)
- > Johnny sees provider
 - Office visit is \$200
 - Johnny pays \$0 (one subsidized visit)
- > Johnny gets x-ray (billed to your insurance)
 - X-Ray is \$100
 - I-SHIP pays \$75
 - Johnny pay \$25
- > Johnny gets generic medication
 - Johnny pays \$20
- > Johnny pays total of \$45.



Your First Visit

> Hall Health Center

- Subsidized visit
- Deductible waived
- **\$45**
- > In-network
 - No subsidized services
 - Deductible applies
 - Johnny pays \$170
- > Non-network
 - Johnny pays \$200+
- > \$45 vs. \$170 vs. \$200+

Can I Waive ISHIP?

- You are an exchange or "visiting" student attending UW through an official exchange program sponsored by a UW department or the UW Office of International Programs & Exchanges.
- > You are funded by your government, or the US government.
- > You receive health insurance from a US employer of your parent, spouse, or domestic partner.
- > You are enrolled at UW but are doing research outside of the US.
- > You are working in the US and are receiving health insurance through your employer.

How to Waive ISHIP?

- > Submit online waiver request at ISHIP website
 - Must submit by 1pm of the tuition deadline (October 13th!).
